From Vermont & points Southwest:

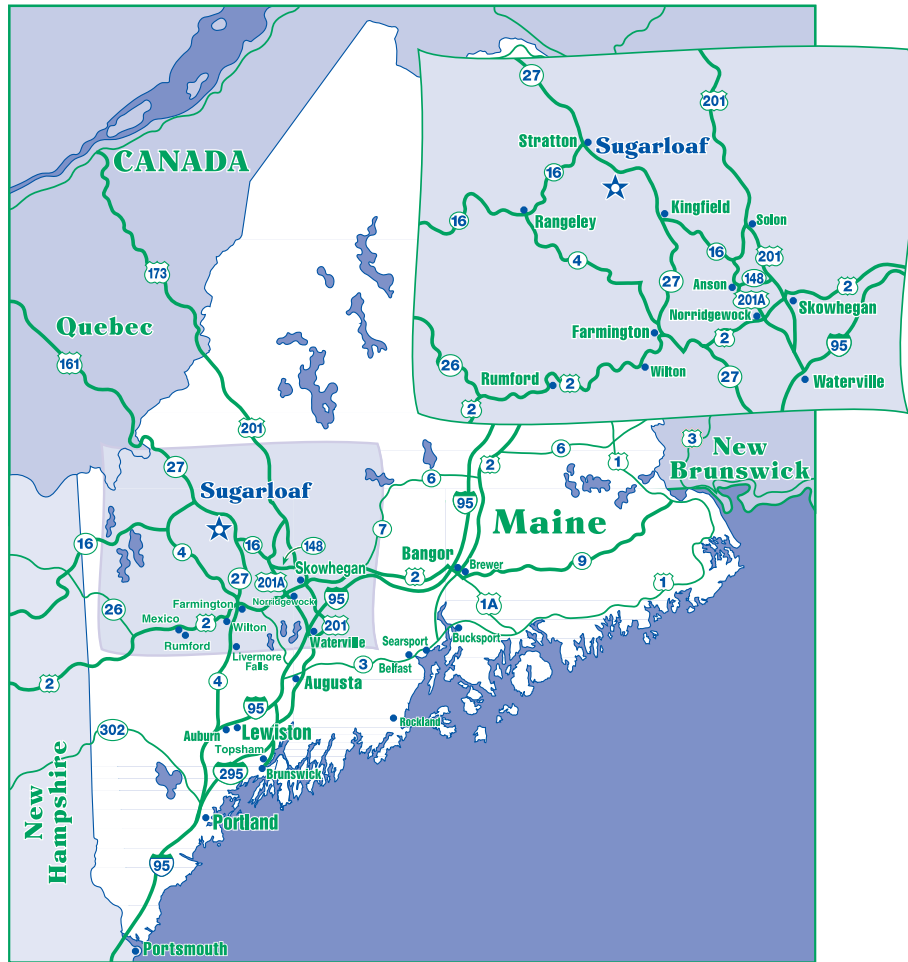
